# ECON 2901-B 2<sup>nd</sup> Term, 2021-2022 Guided Studies in Current Economic Problems I Course Outline

**Course Description**: This course involves group consultations, classroom discussions and presentation of research projects. Students are expected not only to gain basic knowledge in the design of an appropriate research project but also to improve their public speaking and overall writing abilities.

**Learning Outcomes**: After taking this course, students should be able to carry out and present the findings of their own research project.

### **Group Research Project**

Students will form groups of 2 people for a research project (for special reasons, with the approval of the instructor, individual or 3-people projects will be allowed). Each group is expected to meet the course instructor for consultation by appointments. The consultation helps to prepare your project by providing suggestions on ideas, methodology, and/or data. You can email the instructor to set up a meeting time. At the end of the semester, students will give a 15-min in-class presentation and submit a final report. Students are required to produce a poster for the group project and present their work in a public exhibition at the end of April. Students are expected to explain their work to an audience with little or no formal economics training.
