COURSE DESCRIPTION

This course, designed for final year majors, aims at integrating holistically the economics knowledge acquired by the student from the diverse major and elective courses prescribed in the programme. In particular, students are to apply what they have learnt to analyze and understand real economic events and to predict future economic trends and phenomena. Economic issues and problems of current interest will be emphasized. Through experiential learning, students gain useful insights in the demands of different occupations (including postgraduate studies) and become better informed in their own career planning.

- 1. Confidently command and apply economic knowledge to their future work.
- 2. Possess a mindset of lifelong career development related to economics.
- 3. Disseminate their insights in economics to current/future students in economics
